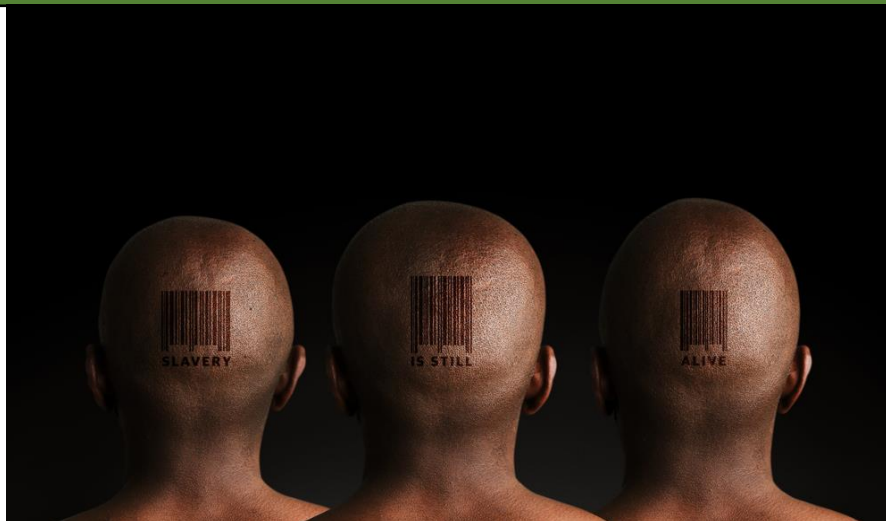
- 7 Mandatory Criteria

1. Identify Reporting Entity/Entities
2. Describe Structure, Operations and Supply Chains
3. Describe Risks of Modern Slavery in global operations and supply chains
4. Describe actions to address risks
5. Describe how effectiveness is assessed
6. Consultation with subsidiaries
7. Any other relevant information

Modern Slavery

Modern Slavery as defined by the Commonwealth Modern Slavery Act 2018

- Trafficking in persons
- Slavery
- Servitude
- Forced labour
- Forced marriage
- Debt bondage
- The worst forms of child labour
- Deceptive recruiting for labour or services



Fundamental principles and rights at work - Eight Fundamental ILO Conventions

1. Freedom of Association and Protection of the Right to Organise Convention, 1948 (No. 87)
2. Right to Organise and Collective Bargaining Convention, 1949 (No. 98)
3. Forced Labour Convention, 1930 (No. 29) (and its 2014 Protocol)
4. Abolition of Forced Labour Convention, 1957 (No. 105)
5. Minimum Age Convention, 1973 (No. 138)
6. Worst Forms of Child Labour Convention, 1999 (No. 182)
7. Equal Remuneration Convention, 1951 (No. 100)
8. Discrimination (Employment and Occupation) Convention, 1958 (No. 111)

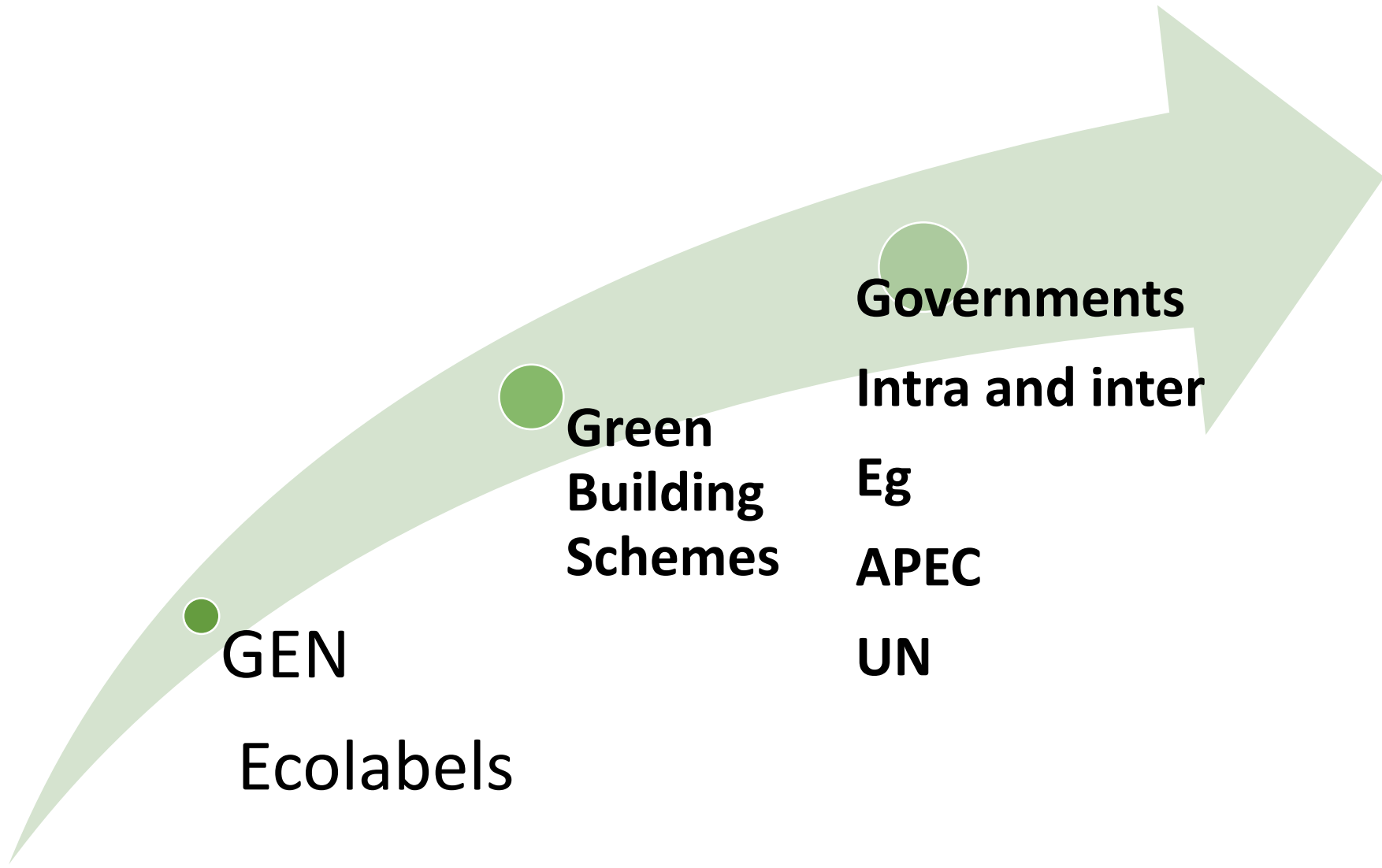

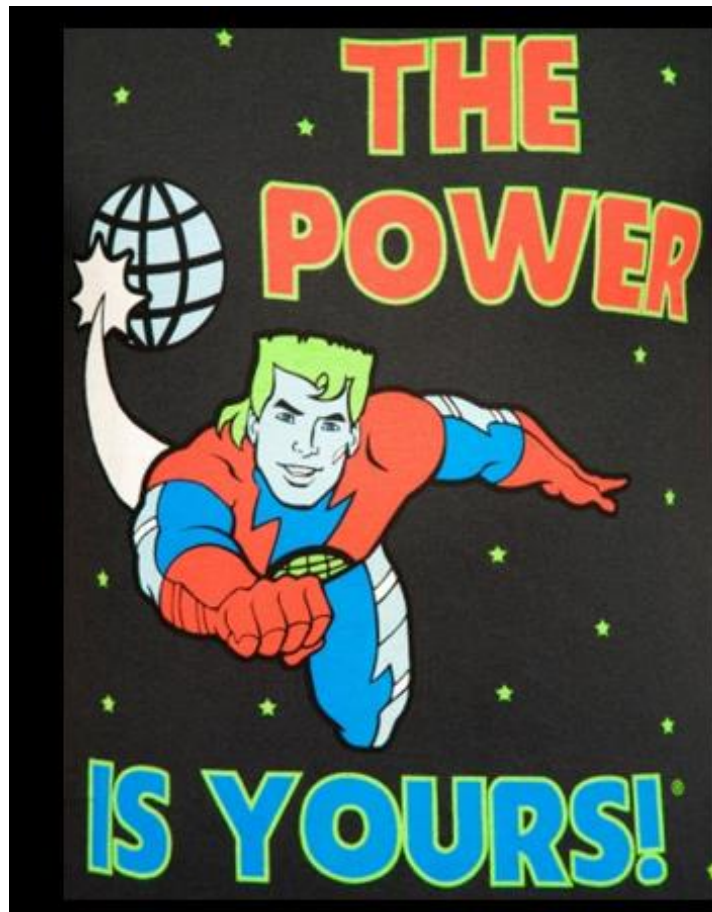
